Senior Adam Rohrbaugh is a saxophone section leader for Marching band and also plays in the Concert and Jazz bands. He began playing alto sax in 4th grade. He participated in Elementary and Middle school bands then joined the Marching band in 8th grade. He also participated in Indoor Drumline for two seasons.

Adam lives in Glen Rock with his parents, Craig and Jen, and older brother, DJ, who graduated in 2020 and was also a band member.

Adam is a Life Scout member of Troop 24 in New Freedom. He has an Eagle Scout project planned and will execute it in late September 2021. This summer, Adam journeyed to Philmont Scout Reservation near Cimarron, New Mexico. He and his Dad hiked 60 miles over 10 days carrying 45-pound backpacks with everything needed to survive, including cookware, food, tents, water and personal items. There were ten people in the crew—3 adults and 7 boys. The trek included hiking mountains, crossing creeks and meeting other crews and staff members. Adam's favorite part of the trek was the views and scenery.



Adam has also been a member of the Glen Rock Carolers since 6th grade. The Carolers sing every Christmas Eve beginning at midnight at the square in Glen Rock and continue around town until morning singing English Christmas carols.
